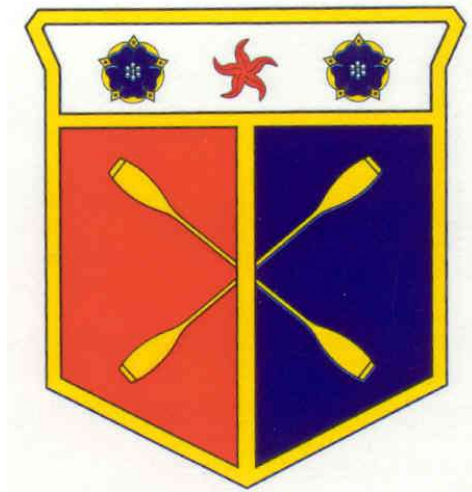

## 2024 Race – Directors’ Comments

This year’s DW, the 74<sup>th</sup> race, presented paddlers with a significant challenge in that flow conditions on the lower canal and River Thames were especially high, indeed the highest levels that the race has been run in for many years. The River Thames had been on red boards for much of the winter, impeding paddlers’ opportunities to train on the river, but the flow had begun to drop 2 weeks before the race giving rise to hope that the 2024 race would run in normal river conditions.

However, on the Thursday before the race Storm Nelson came through southern England, bringing large volumes of rainfall throughout the day. With the ground sodden from the wet winter, this rainfall quickly found its way into the canal and river and water levels and flows rose very quickly throughout the day. Parts of the canal around Crofton became swamped and as the surge moved down the course the flow levels increased substantially. By Friday evening this surge had reached Richmond and triggered the Port of London’s Ebb Tide Red Flag warning which remained in place until Sunday evening. This meant that the Senior Doubles race had to be terminated at Teddington Lock, which in turn prevented the possibility of any records being broken.

The Stages Classes, with the exception of the Junior Doubles, all finished at Teddington Lock as well on the Sunday afternoon – this was some 600m shorter than the planned finish at Thames Young Mariners. The Junior Doubles race finished at Dreadnought Reach, and once again trophies and medals have been awarded for this shortened course.

As an additional safety measure, paddlers in Classes that raced on the River Thames section of the course were all subject to the DW Enhanced Screening Process, and it is testament to their preparation for the race that no paddlers were screened out this year, despite the difficult river conditions.

In the Senior Doubles Race, the pre-race talk was whether Tom Sharpe could achieve back to back wins and at the same time set a mixed record with new partner Anoushka Freeman. There were 2 other fancied crews, Billy Buttler with Jon O’Grady and Tom Simmons partnering 2022 winner Andrew Birkett. Just 3 ½ minutes separated these 3 boats at Newbury, but by Reading this had grown to 8 minutes with Sharpe and Freeman in the lead. They held this position to Teddington to take the win by 25 minutes – only the third time a mixed crew has won the Senior Doubles Class. However, the DW is not only about winners, and all 43 boats that finished the 2024 race are to be congratulated on their achievement. The conditions were tough, and with the night-time being particularly dark, navigating down the course was not at all easy. The completion figure of 63% is the joint lowest since 2008.

In the Junior Doubles, Max Prins-Mills and Aiden Teeuwen from Reading Canoe Club successfully defended their trophy (only the 5<sup>th</sup> time this has happened since 1953), but they were pushed hard by Elliot Davies and Gabe Davies from Wey Kayak Club. DW is most grateful to Bryanston School and Churcher's College who have donated annual trophies for this Class for second and third place.

In the Senior Singles Class, Dan Palmer from Truro Canoe Club finished first on all 3 days and took the win overall, and at the same time completed his 8<sup>th</sup> DW continuing his record of never finishing outside the top 3 in his Class of entry. The Veteran-Junior crew of Almir Balla and Serhii Pavlyshyn from Barking and Dagenham Canoe Club were impressive winners in a time of 13 hrs and 47 mins – only a few minutes outside the Senior Doubles winning time!

The DW has two trophies that seek nominations from the DW community, The Sir Louis and Lady Gluckstein Trophy, awarded to the crew or individual displaying exceptional courage and fortitude, and the Jon White Trophy, for the disabled paddler, or paddlers, displaying exceptional determination and resolve over adversity.

A number of nominations for the Gluckstein Trophy have been received, each of them meritorious in their own way. The Directors have considered the nominations carefully against the benchmarks of previous years and have concluded that no award will be made in 2024. There were no nominations for the Jon White Trophy this year.

The final, non-racing based trophy open to paddlers is the Pfeiffer Cup. Awarded to the paddler, or crew, that raises the most money for Charity, this trophy enables competitors to help others through their efforts. The Directors are delighted to announce that the 2024 winners are Sarah Williams and Georgie Syms from Wey Kayak Club, who raised a staggering amount of £18,715 for the Motor Neurone Disease Association.

We and the DW Team look forward to welcoming paddlers, together with their friends and family, to the Prize Giving ceremony to celebrate in everyone's success and achievements during the 2024 DW.

The entries across the senior classes have been significantly lower in the last 3 years since the covid pandemic putting the organisation under financial strain. We hope that 2025 and celebrating the 75<sup>th</sup> DW will re-invigorate the DW community and see increased entries.
